Count on and back 0-10 accurately and confidently	Clearly without hesitation	Start at 3 and continue to 10 and back.
Read numbers to 10	Recognises the numeral.	Can they read a house number or numbers on a number plate.
Say 1 more than any number between 0 and 10	One more than 2 is 3	There are seven beads in this pot. If I put one more in the pot how many would there be?
Say 1 less than any number between 0 and 10	1 less than 8 is 7	There are ten sweets in a jar. I am taking one sweet out of the jar. How many are left?

Read numbers to 20	Recognise numerals	Can read house numbers or page numbers.
Count on from any number up to 20		Start at 6 Count on. Start at 9 count forwards.
Show number bonds to 10	Know 2 numbers that add to make 10.	If you raise 4 fingers how many are hidden? If you give then 7 cars Can your child find how many cars they need to make 10?
Count back from any number below 20	Clearly without hesitation	Start on 18, count back until 0. Start on 16 count down.
Write numbers in numerals	Write numbers picked randomly	Write a phone number. Write a house number.

0.3 Spain	Explanation	Can your child...
Add 2 single digit numbers	Add by counting on	If I have 4 marbles and I add 5 more how many will I have? Your child counts on from 4 until they have added 5 possibly using objects or fingers.
Say 1 more and 1 less number between 0 and 20		What is 1 more than 15. 1 less than 14. What is the next number after 17? What number comes before 19
Add a single digit number to any number to 20.	Add by counting on from the largest number.	If I have 16 spoons and then I add 2 more how many will I have? Your child says 16 and then add 2 more spoons saying 17 and 18.
Write numbers 0-10 in words	Write: One two three etc	Write numbers in words.
