Part of our school budget is based on the number of children eligible for free school meals. If you are in receipt of the following, you may be entitled to Free School Meals – even if you do not wish to claim the lunches, please let Mrs Burnard know, so we can claim the funding as a school. Thank you.

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

With ongoing restrictions linked to Covid19, our after school clubs will be very limited for the time being and those that do run must be for class bubbles to avoid the mixing of children. We hope to offer an after school sports club on a Thursday, 3.00 - 3.45 - there will be a small charge for this. Information next week. Foxes will be able to participate in a Thursday, lunchtime sports club, starting next week.

Through our Jig-Saw PSHE lessons, we have considered how we manage our fears and anxieties. This links with our whole school Biblical teaching:


