Incarnation	 A:2 Christians celebrate the birth of Jesus at Christmas time. Christians believe that Jesus is God and that he was born as a baby in Bethlehem. Advent for Christians is a time of getting ready for Jesus' coming. Wise men brought gifts for Jesus and treated him like a king. Christians believe that Christmas is a time for giving. B:2 Everybody started life as a baby. Christians believe that Jesus was God come to earth. Mary was Jesus' mother and Joseph was her husband. Jesus was born in a stable. Angels told shepherds about the baby. Wise men brought gifts for the baby. We celebrate the birth of Jesus with our Christingle service. 	 B:4 People waved Palm leaves to welcome Jesus to Jerusalem. We now call this Palm Sunday. Christians are given a palm cross at church to remind them about the palm leaves and that Jesus died on a cross. Hot cross buns have a cross on the top. We eat these at Easter time. Christians believe that Jesus died on the cross on Good Friday but came back from the dead three days later. Christians believe that Jesus died on the cross so that we can be forgiven for the wrong that we do. 	 Christians believe that Jesus is willing to forgive all people even those that put him on the cross. That Jesus did this to build a bridge between man and God. By rising from the dead he gives Christians a hope in a new life. Because of Easter, Christians believe in life after death. B:4 Christians see Holy Week as the peak of Jesus' earthly life, leading to his death and resurrection. Palm Sunday is called this because when Jesus rode into Jerusalem people waved and put down palm leaves to welcome him. Jesus washed his disciples feet at the last supper to show humility and to teach that everyone should care for each other. Judas betrayed Jesus to the Romans. Jesus was crucified and died on the cross but rose from the dead three days later- this is called the resurrection. Most Christians believe that Jesus rose from the dead and so is alive today. For Christians, the Kingdom of God is not a country or land, but is wherever God is the ruler of human lives. Whoever calls God their King and follows God's way is part of this Kingdom.
