Acorn Education Trust is providing three school hubs, that will remain open over the Easter Holidays, to support Key Workers. These Hubs will be based at The Avenue, Clarendon Academy and Wansdyke School.

Please note that the Easter Holiday Support Hubs are ONLY open to children of Key Workers with no other child care options.

Open Days: Easter Holiday weekdays (inc Good Friday and Easter Monday)

Opening Hours: 9am – 3pm

Uniform: students can wear their own clothes

Lunches: students will need to bring their own packed lunches. A packed lunch will be provided for students who receive free school meals

Please note you'll need to arrange transport for your child to and from the Hub
